Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate, fittingly, in the wake of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which fell on Friday. I am pleased to announce that Bishop Rice has made time to be with us for the 10:30 a.m. Mass this weekend. It's a privilege to have our chief shepherd with this little flock on such a momentous occasion. We welcome Bishop Rice with affection and thanks.

Thank you to Joan Woods and the PCCW for their help with food and games this weekend; thank you to Mark Stanek and the Knights of Columbus for cooking, thank you to Mindy Yocom and the Parish Council Members, and our wonderful office staff for all of their help and contributions toward our celebrations this weekend. Thank you to our parishioners for making time to celebrate this diamond jubilee.

Sunday we will offer a walk through tour of our newly renovated office space addition.
