Dear Parishioners.

This weekend we hold our Parish Council Election at all Masses. Ballots will be distributed by the ushers. Please use the boxes next to the photographs and bios for the purpose of selecting three candidates. Thank you to each of the candidates for their willing hearts of service.

Thank you to all those who reached out to me as I have been recovering from my recent surgery. Your kind words, thoughtful prayers, get well notes and inquiries have all been very much appreciated. Thank you also to those who prepared a meal during this time. It is a blessing to be surrounded by so many kind hearts.

Many of you may be aware of the recent and severe earthquakes in Haiti, which have left much destruction and long lasting impacts on the people there. Catholic Relief Services have been and will continue to be on the ground providing relief. Bishop Rice has requested our diocesan parishes to take up a voluntary special collection, which will become part of the US Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund, for distribution in Haiti.
