The liturgical year concludes this weekend with the celebration of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Next Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent and the start of a new liturgical year. Please take notice of the following "prayerful possibilities" you may want to consider:

- putting together a family Advent Wreath—(Our PCCW has handmade a limited number that will be available the First Sunday of Advent, free of charge for those who might not be able to provide/make their own.);
- online Advent day-by-day reflections can be signed up for and will arrive each

 and also check out Living Advent means Living Joy with Chris Stefanick;
- a limited number of Advent reflection booklets will be available in the back of church the first weekend of Advent. We will have a few copies available in LARGE PRINT for those who might need it.

December 12th is the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. It is also the time in which our parish will gather in our beautifully renovated hall to fill our bellies with a Mexican food feast in honor of Our Lady and in anticipation of Christmas. Once our bellies have been adequately filled and with our hearts full of fellowship, we will then have the opportunity to spill our sins in a parish penance service that will commence at 2:00 p.m. that same day. Several priests from our deanery will be on hand to assist with confessions as well as several of our retired priests and our own Fr. Pat. Mark your calendars and plan to join us for this fill and spill. This event will take the place of our monthly first Sunday Whole Family Catechesis.
