This weekend we welcome Fr. Timothy from CMR in Carthage. Fr. Timothy will be covering the Masses this weekend as I must attend to some vocation director responsibilities. Thank you Fr. Timothy for your presence and assistance.

At this time of writing news continues to break of the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Last weekend we took up the annual special collection for the church in Central and Eastern Europe. This weekend we sadly see the peoples of the Ukraine and the Church in that part of Europe facing dire threats to life and religious freedoms. I ask that all parishioners offer a rosary for an end to these aggressions, protection for the men, women and children under attack and a conversion of heart for the aggressors. Please pray for our country at this time of decisive action and policy on the part of our leaders and our president that they may have wisdom to do what is necessary in defense of freedom, democracy, and human life.
