Dear Parishioners,

Thank you to Fr. Pat for assisting with our Parish Penance Service while our number of confessors was quite lower than expected, our number of confessee's was higher than anticipated. This is a happy problem!!! Thank you to all those who took this Lenten opportunity in preparation for Easter. There will be further opportunities for those who were unable to make it at neighboring parishes in the coming weeks. Additionally, I will be in the confessional available to hear confessions on Tuesdays from 6:00-6:30 (or as long as there are people waiting). We will also continue to have our regular confession times, 6:00-6:15 Saturday evening and Sunday morning 7:30-7:45.

Please remember Stations of the Cross are being prayed communally on Fridays from 6:00-6:30 p.m. with Mass at 6:30 (or immediately following Stations).

The office has been informed by our Grand Knight that the Knights of Columbus, out of an abundance of caution, have decided not to offer Lenten Fish Fries again this year. The Knights of Columbus are exploring other fundraisers for their projects. We will keep you posted as we learn more. If you are a young man ages 18-80 and have not yet joined the Knights of Columbus, now is a great time to do so. Please see any current member or visit with our Grand Knight, Bob Bowes.

Thank you to all who responded so generously to the Bishop's call among all our parishes to take up a second collection for the support of those currently suffering in the Ukraine. - 3—Review your day. In your imagination, retrace your steps of your day—what you did, whom your encountered, thoughts and feelings you experience;
- 4-Talk with God. Tell God the things you feel good about and those you regret;
- 5-Look toward the day to come. Ask God to help you be your best self as you look forward to tomorrow.
