Dear Parishioners,

Last week I asked all parishioners to offer a rosary for an end to violence, hostility and bloodshed in the Ukraine. Thank you to all who were able to do so. If you have not yet done so, I renew my request and ask that a rosary be offered for these intentions. We continue to see the peoples of the Ukraine and the Church in that part of Europe facing dire threats to life and religious freedoms. Let us continue to pray for our country at this time of decisive action and policy on the part of our leaders and our president that they may have wisdom to do what is necessary in defense of freedom, democracy, and human life.

Lent is about taking up our crosses each day and following more closely the footsteps of our Lord Jesus Christ. It's about recognizing the joy of Jesus who is present each day to all of us in the Mass, at prayer, and in our homes and community. I offer the following simple steps as a suggestion to deepen your prayer each evening throughout Lent. I pray that they are helpful to you.

- 1-Find a quiet place. Remember that you are in the holy presence of God;
- 2-Give thanks. Name one moment from your day for which you are grateful;
- 3—Review your day. In your imagination, retrace your steps of your day—what you did, whom your encountered, thoughts and feelings you experience;
- 4-Talk with God. Tell God the things you feel good about and those you regret;
- 5-Look toward the day to come. Ask God to help you be your best self as you look forward to tomorrow.

We heartily welcome Fr. James Mason, who joins us this weekend as promised at all weekend Masses and to present our Lenten Parish Mission Sunday night and Monday night. As announced the last two weekends in the bulletin insert, Fr. Fr. Mason attended seminary with me in Rome. We are delighted to have him with us and look forward to the spiritual treasures awaiting us.
