We welcome this weekend, the Very Rev. Fr. James Mason, President Rector at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis for our weekend Masses and parish mission. It is my hope that this special event has been on your calendar and that many of our parishioners and families will be attending.

We are pleased to report that one of our two December 2021 Giving Tuesday projects has been completed!!! If you haven't already seen it on Facebook at our church page, please be sure to notice it this weekend. Watch the sign for encouraging messages, important updates and timely announcements. Thank you to all of our good parishioners for their past support of Giving Tuesday. The next project is as promised, the replacement of the main altar.

Recently our insurance adjuster was onsite following the severe hail we had several weeks ago. The adjuster has informed us that the roof on the rectory and the hall will need replacing. Additionally, we are told guttering and siding on the rectory and guttering on the hall will need replacing. We are waiting to find out the status of the church building and office.

Our DDF goal this year is \$31,877 here at Sacred Heart. The last two years we have met and well exceeded our goal at Sacred Heart. This is due to your continued support of our diocesan ministries as well as the office of the Bishop and his work as our shepherd. A number of folks have already turned their pledge in, at this time, which was received in the mail by all registered households of the parish.
