Dear Parishioners,

Congratulations to our newly ordained priests in service to the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau. Friday evening Bishop Rice ordained three transitional deacons to the Holy Priesthood. We are blessed as a diocese to have Fr. Charlie Peirano, Fr. Jesse Hielt and Fr. Nicholas Newton. Fathers Peirano and Newton will receive parish assignments in July, Fr. Hielt will return to Chicago for an additional year for advanced studies. Additionally, last Friday Bishop Rice ordained Nick Zummo to the diaconate. Deacon Nick will spend the summer serving in Lebanon before returning to continued studies as he prepares for the priesthood next spring. We are happy to welcome Deacon Nick to our deanery and look forward to seeing him around.

Please keep in your prayers Cody Berkett who leaves on Wednesday of this coming week for Wichita where he will be trained with others as a Totus Tuus missionary. Cody will be the second Totus Tuus missionary sent from our parish family. (Ryan Briggs was our first!) Following training he will spend eight weeks in our diocesan parishes with his team working with young people from elementary through high school to share the faith.

Our Sacred Heart Parish family, over the last several weeks, has experienced a significant amount of heartache with the passing of long-time parishioners, both unexpected as well as following battles with illness. In addition, over the course of the past several years through COVID and even before, we have experienced deaths in our community and families.
