Dear Parishioners,

We are happy to welcome Fr. Tuan, the new pastor of St Elizabeth in El Dorado and St. Peter's in Stockton. Fr. Tuan takes the place of Fr. Gregory as the newest priest in our deanery. If you are in those areas this summer please be sure to say hello and welcome him. Fr. Tuan is a priest of the Congregation of the Mother of the Redeemer in Carthage.

Recently there was a heinous act of vandalism at St. Elizabeth in El Dorado, where vandals destroyed the statue of the Blessed Mother at the entrance to the church. This coincided with the Roe vs. Wade Supreme Court ruling as it happened only several days after. Please keep your eyes out around our parish grounds for anything/anyone that might be out of place or suspicious and if you see something, say something.




