Dear Parishioners:

Friday, June 16th, marks the annual celebration of our parish Feast Day. Please come join us as we celebrate the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Mass will begin at 6:00 p.m. in the Main Church, followed by a parish picnic. Thank you to the Knights of Columbus, who will be grilling burgers and brats provided by the parish. Please bring a side dish, salad or dessert to share. Please also bring lawn chairs and any outdoor yard games. If you have corn hole, if you have ring toss, if you have wiffle ball, or anything else, we need you!!! The meal will be served in the Parish Hall at 7:30 p.m. Yard games and drinks will follow Mass immediately.

Congratulations to Deacon Jim who celebrates his 5th anniversary of ordination and Fr. Pat who celebrates 59th anniversary of ordination this month of May.

Congratulations to our graduate John Valerio on his graduation from high school. We will have a reception for John after the 8:00 a.m. Mass this weekend. John plans to go to OTC this summer and then attend Mizzou in the fall.

Recently our Parish Council discussed having a procession on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 11th, (The Solemnity of the Body & Blood of Christ). It is at the request of Bishop Rice that our diocesan parishes highlight this great solemnity in light of the Eucharistic Revival taking place and in preparation for the National Eucharistic Congress in 2024. To this end, we have decided to hold our Eucharistic procession at St. Wenceslaus Cemetery. In order to call to mind both the sacredness of that place and the connection of the Church Militant (the faithful on earth, the Church Triumphant, the faithful in heaven, and the church suffering-those in purgatory) all united in the Most Holy Eucharist. When we pray before the Blessed Sacrament, we pray for one another, for those who have gone before us, and for those in purgatory. As we adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, we see the Way, the Truth and the Life to which we are called. Please mark your calendars for this unique opportunity. The procession will begin immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass at Sacred Heart. We will have a procession in vehicles to the cemetery where we will continue a procession on foot with the Most Holy Sacrament. The procession will end under the awning with a time of prayer and Benediction. Please feel free to bring lawn chairs if standing is difficult for you. Those that can are asked to walk in the procession. There will be an ice-cream social following the procession and benediction. Please bring a topping to share. Ice-cream, bowls, napkins, etc. will be provided.

We currently have 89 hearts displayed at the inside entrance of the church. Each heart represents a single gift from a donor/household. Please remember that we are focusing NOT on the amount, but on the number of people/households participating. Every gift is important and every gift makes a difference. Thank you to those who have participated. I ask that if you have not yet done so that you please take a moment this week, to join your heart and your participation to the hearts already displayed so that our Amazing Parish can fill the space on the wall!!!

Mark your calendars for our annual Memorial Day Mass at St. Wenceslaus Cemetery (Karlin). Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 a.m. followed by breakfast and or coffee at Smith's in a reserved space. Please bring your own chairs, and sun protection. In the event of rain the Mass will be celebrated at Sacred Heart (Bolivar).
