Dear Parishioners:

Thank you for the prayers as I served last weekend as a Spiritual Director for the women's Cursillo weekend in Carthage.

I'm happy to say we had a participant in the weekend from our parish here at Sacred Heart! For those who have made Cursillo in the past, you know what a blessing it is. For those who have never made a Cursillo weekend, I would invite you to do so next Fall or Spring.

We are hoping to collect a list of names for those at Sacred Heart Parish who have made a Cursillo weekend in the past. Please call or email the office and let us know if you are one of these people know as Cursillistas. It's our hope that we may begin small grouping in the near future.

Our Parish Leadership Team (PLT) has identified that we *prioritize prayer* as the Body of Christ as one of our parish objectives. In order to do this we have created our own Sacred Heart Parish prayer that can be found on the front cover of our pew missals. We ask and invite all parishioners to join us as begin praying this prayer at the start of every Mass. Thank you to the Swihart Painting company for bringing needed complementarity and a consistency to our beautiful and amazing parish.

We welcome Dr. Mark Zia, of Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas to Sacred Heart the weekend of May 19/20, 2023. Dr. Mark Zia is a professor of theology, husband, father, and owner of a Catholic book and gift shop that also sells *REAL* Italian gelato!
