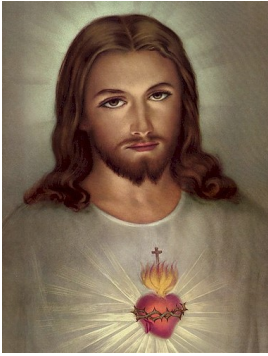
UPC LABELS: Our parish is collecting UPC labels from Best Choice.
