We are currently at 113 donors to our annual DDF appeal at Sacred Heart. I am truly grateful to each and every donor for their participation. As we have entered into the month of July it is my hope that those who have not yet taken a moment to participate will do so now. Our goal is 175 participants which means we need 62 additional families/individuals who will join their fellow parishioners (and myself) in taking part. Please prayerfully reflect and return your donor cards in the next several weeks, otherwise Bev Swihart will come looking for you!

Just outside of Cape Girardeau and a little beyond our diocesan border lies Perryville, Missouri located in the archdiocese of St. Louis. Many may not know that one of the crown jewels of Perryville is the National Shrine of the Miraculous Medal, a site of pilgrimage and prayer under the care of the Vincentian Fathers. During this year of Eucharistic Revival, we would like to offer a Parish Pilgrimage to the Shrine. The two options for this overnight excursion would be Saturday, August 12th, returning Sunday, August 13th OR Thursday, October 12th, and returning Friday, October 13th.
