**REQUIREMENTS(Requirement for all diocesan/parish personnel-**

**clergy, employees, adult volunteers):** The mission and ministry of creating a safe environment for all to flourish and thrive is a responsibility we all share. Before regularly working or volunteering with minors or vulnerable adults, all diocesan personnel are required to first complete 1) the Safe Environment Training; 2) have a Background Screening conducted; and 3) submit a signed Code of Conduct.

The Safe Environment training is now available online after creating an account in the VIRTUS system (through the VIRTUS webpage) <https://www.virtusonline.org/virtus/>

The Code of Conduct, which is required annually, the Background Disclosure and Authorization, and other Safe Environment Policies and required forms are available on the Diocese website, under the Office of Child and Youth Protection <https://dioscg.org/child-youth-protection/>.
