The 2023 Sacrament of Confirmation with Bishop Rice will be taking place on Sunday, September 24th at the 10:30 a.m. Mass here at Sacred Heart. Our PCCW ladies will be hosting DeSales Catholic Bookstore after all Masses on the weekend of September 9th & 10th. Plan now to pick up your Confirmation gifts of prayer cards, medals, books and the like, while supporting our ladies. Thank you to them for this great opportunity.
