This **December 27, 2023**, will mark the 350th anniversary of the revelation of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Our diocese is blessed with 12 parishes named in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. During the 350th anniversary, which begins on the date of the first apparition, Dec. 27, and will conclude next year on Dec. 27, 2024, you are encouraged to grow in their devotion and love for the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
