Dear Parishioners.

With Judy having passed shortly before Christmas, I know it would be a deep consolation to see many familiar parish family faces in this Christmas season time reminding Jim and the family that the coming of Jesus in the manger scatters the darkness and brought light to the waiting world.

"Happy New Year of our Lord 2024!" Having had the opportunity to share greetings for this calendar new year with many of you at holy day Masses on January 1, and the vigil Mass the night before, I'd like to extend that greeting to those I might have missed at that time. The first day of the new year is always dedicated to remembering our Blessed Mother, Mary, under her title "Mother of God." Mama Mary gave God permission and God did great things through her. Recently I saw a quote from St. Mother Teresa which I'd like to share with you as we step into 2024. I hope it will bring us all much comfort and closer to Jesus through Mary as we hold it in our hearts and reflect upon it. Only one passport is necessary per household.
