A timely reminder for all Catholics!!! We observe the first day of Lent beginning with Ash Wednesday. For us, Ash Wednesday is always a day of fasting and abstinence. This means that we do not eat outside of meals nor do we snack throughout the day. Additionally it means we eat one meal and two smaller meals that added together WOULD NOT equal a regular meal. Abstinence means we do not eat meat on that day. It so happens this year that ASH WEDNESDAY FALLS ON VALENTINE'S DAY, FEBRU-ARY 14TH.!?! So...Valentine's Day is a day of fasting and abstinence. Please don't give in to the chocolate covered temptations, the heart shaped whozee-what's-its, and the shiny fluffy doo-dad's that mark Valentine's Day. Instead, I invite you to give your heart to Jesus by receiving your ashes and attending Mass as your Valentine to the Lord. The Church is ALWAYS a good Mother. Thus, she gives us every year Fat Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday. This year let's indulge in our chocolate covered temptations, our heart shaped whozee-what's-it and the shiny, fluffy doo-dad's as well as flowers and fru-fru on Fat Tuesday. We can shower our sweethearts with affection, let the good times roll and then on Ash Wednesday love Jesus more.
