

LENT IS COMING

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



We observe the first day of Lent beginning with Ash For us, Ash Wednesday. Wednesday is always a day of fasting and abstinence. This means that we do not eat outside of meals nor do we snack throughout the day. Additionally it means we eat one meal and two smaller meals that added together WOULD NOT equal a regular meal. Abstinence means we do not eat meat on that day. As you probably by now know, ASH WEDNESDAY FALLS ON VAL-ENTINE'S DAY, FEBRUARY 14TH.!?! So YES! Valentine's Day is a day of fasting and abstinence. I invite you to give your heart to Jesus by receiving your ashes and attending Mass as your Valentine to the Lord. We can celebrate our sweethearts on Mardi Gras this year.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday we will have QR codes strategically placed throughout the church. Each QR code links to a 2 minute video that can be viewed through your phones QR code reader. The videos

give a self guided tour of the church beginning at the main doors. We invite you, your families, your friends (both Catholic and non-Catholic) and neighbors to drop by after weekend Masses or weekdays (8:00a-4:00p). Additionally there will be a few scheduled tour times for groupings to come with earbuds together at one time. Stay tuned for those opportunities. The tours touch on the practical and spiritual background of the items that make up the Lord's House and our house of worship.

Spiritual vitamins continued: Jittery? Take Vitamin J. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. (Hebrews 13:8) Know nothing? Take Vitamin K. Know this that the Lord is God, it is He that made us and not we ourselves. (Ps 100:3) Lonely? Take Vitamin L. Lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. (Micah 6:8)
