If you have not already noticed when attending Ash Wednesday Masses, please take a look at the courtyard between the church and the hall and notice the newly erected monument to the unborn which has been moved from the old Knights of Columbus Hall, cleaned professionally, and installed in this space. This reminder of the smallest and most voiceless among us will keep vigil and help us to remember always to pray for an end to abortion, a greater respect for life, and for all mothers, fathers, children, and families.

Please remember throughout Lent, each Friday, following the 6:00 p.m. Mass we will pray the Stations of the Cross in church. This prayer is an excellent way to live Lent and to spend a bit of time reflecting on the Passion of our Lord and His great love for each of us. You will notice as of tonight, the first Friday of Lent, our brand new beautifully crafted Stations which have been installed in the main church.
