Dear Parishioners,

DO NOT BE MISLED: A deceptive Constitutional Amendment petition is circulating to legalize abortion throughout all stages of pregnancy in Missouri. If successful, once placed on the ballot, during the general elections, it would enshrine a right to abortion in the state constitution and nullify all current state prolife and *PARENTAL NOTIFICATION LAWS*. If you are approached by a seemingly well meaning person collecting signatures in front of stores, gathering places and other locations, first review the text of the proposal. Be aware that they are engaged in the process of collecting approximately 172,000 total valid signatures from registered voters in six out of eight congressional districts. After reading you can just say, "No, thank you." Don't take for granted if they tell you, you are being asked to sign a petition "women's health" or even if it is presented as "pro-life!" **NO PRO-LIFE GROUPS IN MISSOURI ARE COLLECTING SIGNATURES FOR AN INITIATIVE PETITION TO APPEAR ON THE FALL 2024 BALLOT, SO PLEASE DON'T BE FOOLED. DON'T FALL FOR THE TRICK OF "YOU CAN SIGN IT TODAY, BUT STILL VOTE AGAINST IT LATER."** No one should participate in abortion to any degree, it is morally wrong to help put it on the ballot. *PLEASE DECLINE TO SIGN.*
