Dear Parishioners,

This week begins the observance of Holy Week, the highest celebrations of the church year. The liturgies of Holy Week could be likened to a symphony, as they are individual movements of one great whole. Beginning with Passion Palm Sunday, followed by Chrism Mass at St. Agnes Cathedral on Tuesday evening, with Bishop Rice, continuing with Holy Thursday—*Mass of the Lord's Supper*, Good Friday—*Veneration of the Cross*, Holy Saturday—*Easter Vigil* and culminating with Easter Sunday—*the Mass of our Lord's Resurrection*. Each of these movements in this Holy Week invite us to plunge more deeply into the mystery of our faith as we proclaim Christ's life, death and resurrection. I invite you to participate fully or as much as is truly possible by attending and assisting with your presence and prayers. Please see this bulletin in the usual spot for the times and locations.

This Monday, March 25, 5:30 p.m. is our Lenten Penance Service at Sacred Heart. There will be visiting priests here to assist.

Large signs approximately the size of a regular stop sign are available from the Parish Office which bear the message "Decline to Sign." If you would like one for home, office, or other evangelization purposes, please contact the Parish Office. These are free of charge. There are still several remaining if you would like one.

Our parish will again host an Easter Egg Hunt for our young people on Easter Sunday following the 10:30 a.m. Mass of Resurrection. Please make plans to join us and enjoy this time of celebration. There will be two "goose eggs" and one "ostrich egg" which will contain a special cash prize in addition to our regular eggs full of Easter goodies.

Deacon Jim had surgery this past week, as many know. The surgery went well. The pathology report was good (no sign of cancer) and he is currently home resting and recovering. His voice is quiet but audible, his pain level is being managed and he appreciates all of your prayers and asks that you continue to keep him in prayer.

REPORTING PROCEDURES OF KNOWN OR SUSPECTED ABUSE & MISCONDUCT

- Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor must first be immediately reported to the **Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-3738.**
- Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of an adult must first be immediately reported to the **Missouri Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-0210.**
- In situations of immediate danger, call **911.**
- Known or suspected abuse may also be reported to law enforcement in addition to making a report to the MO Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline or to the MO Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline.

Concerns and violations of the Code of Conduct should also be reported to the Director of the Office of Child and Youth Protection at childandyouthprotection@dioscg.org or (417) 866-0841 or through the **TIPS Online Reporting System**, available on the diocesan Website at www.dioscg.org. Violations involving the bishop should also be reported to the Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting Service at 800-276-1562 or at <https://reportbishopabuse.org/>.
