Dear Parishioners,

By now, it's extremely likely you have seen clipboard wielding individuals outside of stores, restaurants, post offices and other public gathering places. I'm guessing you have also seen the red stop sign shaped "DECLINE TO SIGN" postings which we have shared. As I have written about in recent bulletins, there is an attempt to garner as many signatures as possible from unsuspecting individuals in order to amend the Missouri State Constitution, which would legalize abortion throughout ALL stages of pregnancy, nullify ALL current state prolife and parental notification laws. While being called a "Reproductive Freedom" amendment to the constitution it is the exact opposite in every sense. In addition to unlimited and unregulated abortions, it would put women's health at risk by eliminating laws and changing practices that protect innocent life and regulate safety. Do NOT be misled into signing these dangerous and deceptive petitions. Those clipboard wielding individuals are paid employees who receive financial compensation for every signature they solicit.
