As we celebrate Memorial Day let us pray for all those who have served our country in our armed forces and made the ultimate sacrifice on the battle field or as a result of their tour of duty on the battle field. We will have Mass on Memorial Day at St. Wenceslaus Cemetery at 9:30 a.m. Please look elsewhere in this bulletin for more details.

Thank you to those who have already reserved their tickets...don't wait and miss out. Mark your calendars now for an evening movie outing with your fellow parishioners. We have reserved 40 seats at the AMC Theater in Springfield to view the feature film *Jesus Thirsts: "The Miracle of the Eucharist."* This event will kick off our parish feast day celebration. Show time is 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 5th. Tickets are limited and on a first come/first served basis. To reserve yours, call or drop by the parish office in person—no emails please. Tickets are at a special price of \$10 per person.

Continuing with the celebration of our parish feast day we will have a day of Eucharistic Adoration on June 7th, First Friday. We will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:00 a.m. and continue with Adoration until 5:00 p.m. Because the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in the monstrance upon the altar, it is necessary that someone be in the church at all times throughout the day. At the conclusion of Adoration on that day, we will have Benediction immediately followed by our Feast Day Mass at 5:30 p.m. After Mass please plan to stay for a cookout and games with your fellow parishioners. Thanks to our PCCW and Knights of Columbus for helping with the picnic. Please bring your own chairs for outdoor seating, blankets, or anything else for your outdoor comfort.
