Dear Parishioners,

This Wednesday many of us will attend the movie “*Jesus Thirsts: The Miracle of the Eucharist*.” We have reserved 40 seats at the AMC Theater in Springfield. This event will kick off our parish feast day celebration. Show time is 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 5th. **We have 17 tickets left for purchase. To reserve yours, please contact the Parish Office. Tickets are at a special price of \$10 per person.**

Continuing with the celebration of our parish feast day we will have a day of Eucharistic Adoration on June 7th, First Friday. We will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:00 a.m. and continue with Adoration until 5:00 p.m. Because the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in the monstrance upon the altar, it is necessary that someone be in the church at all times throughout the day. A sign up sheet is available beginning this weekend in the vestibule (located on the table beside St. Wenceslaus) arranged in half hour increments. Please consider keeping our Lord company by committing to a time. Feel free to sign up for more than a half hour if you wish. At the conclusion of Adoration on that day, we will have Benediction immediately followed by our Feast Day Mass at 5:30 p.m. After Mass please plan to stay for a cook-out and games with your fellow parishioners. Thanks to our PCCW and Knights of Columbus for helping with the picnic. Please bring your own chairs for outdoor seating, blankets, or anything else for your outdoor comfort. Seating inside is provided. **Burgers, brats and hotdogs will be provided. If your last name begins with: A-E please bring a salad; F-J please bring a side dish; K-O please bring chips and/or dip; P-Z please bring a dessert.**
