Last weekend at Masses on SUNDAY we recognized those who have been parish volunteers and ministers by a special blessing at the end of Mass and the distribution of a beautiful holy card to each. Voting NO on Amendment 3 is voting for life, voting for women, and voting for family. We must bring our faith with us to the polling place and encourage others to do the same. The time is short, please be solicitous in speaking the truth of the Gospel of Life to those you know.
