I wish, as your pastor, to add my thanks for your generosity to the 2024 DDF appeal. Sacred Heart Parish excelled our goal in dollars at 103%. We exceeded our goal in number of donors at 114% and we are numbered in parishes across the diocese that had at least 50% participation compared to the number of registered households at 69%. This is much to be proud of, grateful for, and once again demonstrates the engagement of our people as we support diocesan wide ministries and those of our bishop and benefit from those same ministries as well.
