REPORTING PROCEDURES OF KNOWN OR SUSPECTED ABUSE & MISCONDUCT

- Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor must first be immediately reported to the Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-3738.
- Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of an adult must first be immediately reported to the Missouri Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-0210.
- In situations of immediate danger, call 911.

Known or suspected abuse may also be reported to law enforcement in addition to making a report to the MO Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline or to the MO Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline. Concerns and violations of The Code of Conduct should also be reported to the Office of Child and Youth Protection at 417-866-0841 or by email at childandyouthprotection@dioscg.org or through the TIPS online reporting system available on the diocesan website www.dioscg.org.
