Dear Parishioners,

The launch of Walk with One took place at our parish potluck held on December 8th. At that time we shared with the parish the outline and explanations for the Walk with One initiative. February, we will begin inviting all parishioners to prayerfully Walk with One. Please consider who you will choose to prayerfully invite, encourage, and accompany along the way into a deeper relationship with Jesus and to experience His love and mercy. Watch the bulletin in the coming weeks for more resources and support.

Ash Wednesday is March 5th, just a little more than a month away. Please mark your calendars for Mass on that day. We will offer the regular 8:30 a.m. and a 6:00 p.m. opportunity. Now is a good time to begin thinking about what your Lenten sacrifice/offering will be this year. Remember whether we give something up or take on a good work or prayer commitment, it should help us to mindful of Jesus in His passion and cross and to grow spiritually. It's not about self-help, but rather embracing the cross.

I would like to encourage the men of our parish to attend the diocesan men's conference on February 22nd in Springfield. This day-long event will be a time of prayer, encouragement, fellowship, and discussion. The keynote speaker, Mr. John Edwards, is the founder of Justaguyinthepew.com Ministries and Podcast helping men to become who God intends them to be. If

you are a Catholic man in Sacred Heart Parish or if you love and care for a man in Sacred Heart Parish take note. Following all Masses on February 8/9 and 15/16, there will be a men's conference information and sign-up table in the vestibule. Please stop and visit with our men at the table to find out more and get registered. It is our hope to take a mid-size bus to the conference from the parish parking lot, provided we have enough men who sign up from Sacred Heart. Fathers bring your junior and senior age sons. Juniors and seniors, bring your fathers. Fathers bring your grandfathers...Grandfathers, bring your sons. Women light a fire you know where.

Bishop Edward Rice invites all male parishioners in our diocese to strengthen their relationship with Jesus through a consecration to Jesus through the example of St. Joseph. This begins on February 15th and extends through March 19th, just before Easter. Participants will use the book "*CONSECRATION TO ST JOSEPH*" by Fr. Donald Callaway. Using the book, men will begin reading the daily reflections and prayers and supporting one another along the way. You may remember our ladies in the parish completed the Consecration to Jesus through Mary in December following a similar outline and plan. Sign-ups to get your copy of the book and to be included among our men of Sacred Heart Parish taking this journey together will take place following all Masses starting this weekend February 1/2, and 8/9. Mark your calendars, prepare your hearts, and don't be a bump on a log! Let's grow in holiness together as Catholic men.
