The Lenten Parish Penance Service at Sacred Heart will take place on Sunday, March 23rd at 3 pm. This is an ideal opportunity to attend to our annual Easter Duty as practicing Catholics, by getting to Confession in preparation for the Easter Celebrations. Several priests will travel to be with us and assist in hearing Confessions. Thank you to Fr. David Miller (retired priest of the diocese), Fr. Francis Theetla (pastor at Marshfield), Fr. Tuan Van Nguyen(pastor at Stockton & El Dorado Springs). Let’s make sure they do not travel to assist us in vain!

Thank you to all who attended last weekend’s birthday potluck as we honored Fr. Pat and celebrated 87 years of life and ministry. It was a beautiful event with many people taking part. Special thanks to Dana Landwehr and LuAnn Shinault for coordinating and to all those who assisted them. Thank you also for sharing with us your delicious dishes everyone!

All parishioners are invited each year to join our bishop and the priests of the diocese at the Chrism Mass, **Monday, April 14, 7:00 p.m.**, prior to the Triduum. At this Mass, priests renew their promises made at ordination and the bishop blesses and consecrates the Oil of the Sick, the Oil of Catechumens, and the Oil of Chrism for distribution and sacramental use in all the parishes. It’s a beautiful time to come together in prayer and witness this important part of our Holy Week Liturgies.

Over the next few weeks at various weekend Masses, we will be celebrating the Scrutiny's with our OCIA Catechumens & Candidates. These rites are both an acknowledgement of sin and a blessing and strengthening of the call to conversion in Christ. The first Scrutiny will take place at the 6:30 p.m. Mass this weekend. Please continue to pray for those preparing for the sacraments at Easter and full reception into the Catholic church.
