Welcome Fr. Fergus Monaghan! It's always a delight to have you with us. Thank you for assisting with the Masses this weekend.

Looking ahead to April and the last weekend of that month we are planning the TRIVIA NIGHT for our parish families and any invited guests. If you have a knack for trivia or even if you just like good food, folks and fun, watch the bulletin for further specifics.

The parish family looks forward to welcoming our candidates and catechumens in OCIA at Easter Vigil. Because we have so many participants this year our Parish Council has decided to forgo our regular reception after the vigil Mass, but in it's place we will have a potluck celebration on April 13th, after the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Please make plans, say hello, and welcome our new Catholics.

Thank you to the Knights of Columbus for their support in making possible the acquiring of a church bus to serve the needs of our parish and our parish organizations. We look forward to many adventures together and we also intend to use the bus, which is wheelchair accessible, to make possible a weekend Mass transportation for those who need it.

All parishioners are invited each year to join our bishop and the priests of the diocese at the Chrism Mass, **Monday, April 14, 7:00 p.m.**, prior to the Triduum. At this Mass, priests renew their promises made at ordination and the bishop blesses and consecrates the Oil of the Sick, the Oil of Catechumens, and the Oil of Chrism for distribution and sacramental use in all the parishes. It's a beautiful time to come together in prayer and witness this important part of our Holy Week Liturgies. The Chrism Mass will be held at St. Agnes Cathedral in Springfield.

Over the next few weeks at various weekend Masses, we will be celebrating the Scrutiny's with our OCIA Catechumens & Candidates. These rites are both an acknowledgement of sin and a blessing and strengthening of the call to conversion in Christ. The second Scrutiny will take place at the 8:00 a.m. Mass this weekend. Please continue to pray for those preparing for the sacraments at Easter and full reception into the Catholic church.

If you picked up a CRS Rice Bowl, please return it by Passion/Palm Sunday (April 13). To return your Rice Bowl, please place the entire bowl in a zip-lock bag and seal it. Bags may be left in the sacristy. Please DO NOT return Rice Bowls outside of a bag or leave them in the vestibule. In addition to that, last years blessed palms may also be returned by placing them in the basket under the bulletin board outside the sacristy.
