

Saint of the Week: St. Paul of the Cross

St. Paul of the Cross feast day is October 20th.

Born in northern Italy in 1694, Paul Daneo lived at a time when many regarded Jesus as a great moral teacher but no more. After a brief time as a soldier, he turned to solitary prayer, developing a devotion to Christ’s passion. Paul saw in the Lord’s passion a demonstration of God’s love for all people. In turn that devotion nurtured his compassion and supported a preaching ministry that touched the hearts of many listeners. He was known as one of the most popular preachers of his day, both for his words and for his generous acts of mercy.

In 1720, Paul founded the Congregation of the Passion, whose members combined devotion to Christ’s passion with preaching to the poor, and rigorous penances. Known as the Passionists, they add a fourth vow to the traditional three of poverty, chastity, and obedience, to spread the memory of Christ’s passion among the faithful. Paul was elected superior general of the Congregation in 1747, spending the remainder of his life in Rome.

Paul of the Cross died in 1775, and was canonized in 1867. Over 2,000 of his letters and several of his short writings have survived.

Dear Parishioners,

November 1st is All Saints Day. As usual our parish will observe All Saints with our annual young saints celebration. Our young people and those parishioners young at heart are invited to come and celebrate November 2, after the 10:30 Mass with your best saints costumes. Food will be served and prizes will be given. Be creative, be resourceful and be there!!!

Please note All Saints Day, November 1, is a Holy Day of Obligation. HOWEVER, this year it falls on a Saturday, meaning that the obligation is lifted. WE WILL still have a Holy Day Mass because it is STILL a Holy Day. Mass for All Saints will be offered, November 1, at 8:30 a.m. Beginning with the 4:00 p.m. vigil Mass on November 1, we will observe ALL SOUL’S DAY and this will extend into Sunday. All parishioners are invited to bring pictures of their loved ones who have passed and place them in the vestibule on the altar of the St. Michael shrine. These pictures will remain throughout the month of November and we will offer special prayers for those whose pictures are present. May the souls of the faithful departed through the Mercy of God, rest in peace.

Because All Souls Day falls on a Sunday, we will NOT, have our regular Mass at St. Wenceslaus Cemetery. We WILL have a prayer service and blessing of graves at 3:00 p.m. at St. Wenceslaus. All are invited and encouraged to attend.
