I’m happy to announce that our parish will be the host location for the summer Totus Tuus youth experience. It has been several years since we have hosted this wonderful, faith-filled experience for grades 1 through 6 and 7 through 12. We will welcome the Totus Tuus missionary team during the months of June/July with the exact dates to be announced. Our parish will be the ONLY parish in Deanery 3 to host this event. “Seventy is the sum of our years, or eighty if we are strong, and most of them are fruitless toil, for they pass quickly and we drift away.” (Ps 90:10) These words from the book of Psalm have been on my mind as of late, this year we are celebrating the eightieth year of the existence of St. Catherine Mission in Humansville. Far from fruitless toil, St. Catherine Mission has welcomed many visitors, including those summer lake enthusiasts, in addition to a small and faithful group of registered parishioners. The eighty years of existence have marked many blessings and memories especially for those who have called St. Catherine home. We will always hold these blessings and memories close but with an ever decreasing number of regular attendees, a very limited reception of the sacraments beyond Saturday Mass, and no signs of future growth a difficult decision has been made to close the Mission. Recently, I shared this news with the St. Catherine Mission members, who received it with much grace, and understanding. Several mentioned they were saddened, but not shocked by this reality. We will continue to minister to the needs of the wider parish boundaries and those members of St. Catherine, but will do so from Sacred Heart Parish Church. The final Mass at St. Catherine will be Saturday, June 27th, at 4:00 p.m. and the Mission will officially close July 1st. I wish to thank those members of St. Catherine who have sustained it for these past eighty years in bringing the Mission through eighty years of prayer and good works. We are all stronger for it.
