Dear Parishioners,

Thank you to all who attended our Parish Feast Day as we commemorated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus this past Friday. Are you familiar with the 12 promises Jesus made regarding His Most Sacred Heart and those who observe this devotion from which our parish is named? Have you enshrined the image of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus in your home? All who attended Friday’s celebration were given a beautiful Sacred Heart of Jesus consecration packet which includes an image suitable for framing and display. Those who did not make it on Friday may also receive a packet after all Masses (June 13 and 14) this weekend.

Thank you to our Knights of Columbus who made a \$5,000 donation to our parish library in order to purchase approximately 250 books with an emphasis on titles for children and teens on various topics of faith, the saints, the moral life and the teachings of the church, “age appropriate”. The library will be christened “The Most Chaste Heart of Joseph Library” in honor of the roll of St. Joseph protecting the Holy Family and in recognition of the roll the Knights of Columbus pulled as an organization of Catholic men sharing charity, unity, and fraternity as leaders and protectors of Catholic families today.
